

To realize this vision, we will look to the Town of Wilton to fulfill its financial obligation as Ambler Farm's owner. These efforts will ensure that Ambler Farm remains a cornerstone of Wilton's heritage, while continuing to provide meaningful connections for the community to the land, our animals, and with each other.

In the past year, Friends of Ambler Farm has...

2024 Restoration efforts on town owned buildings were funded through a Connecticut state grant received by the Friends of Ambler Farm:

- Repainted both the white carriage barn and red barn
- Replaced the roof and gutters on the white carriage barn and new roof on the red barn

Thanks to ASML's generous grant, ASML volunteers, and our youth Apprentices, we have... Rebuilt three significant gardens in the Program Area including a preschool garden, raspberry garden and herb garden. The new preschool garden enabled us to nearly double our preschool summer camp capacity in one year.

We have enjoyed 9 weeks of summer camp with **1,199 happy campers**, plus **44 field trips**, **120+ apprentices**, and **over 11,900** educational program **participants** who enjoyed the improvements in the program area.



Provided dozens of scholarships for field trips and summer campers.

Additional grants included...

- We procured and installed a **new evaporator** funded by a generous grant that supported our 6 weeks of maple sugaring reaching over 1,000 program participants.
- We secured a generous grant by Tauck to help support the work on a new outdoor gathering area for the Raymond Ambler House, which will be done once the Town secures the necessary funding needed to complete the remainder of the house.
- We raised private donations which funded the first phase of the educational garden renewal project.
